The Veterans Administration has grants like the VA's Specially Adapted Housing (SAH) or Home Improvements and Structural Alterations (HISA) grants, to assist disabled Veterans adapt their homes. We have completed the process to be a VA builder, and have familiarized ourselves with the various grants and benefits offered to support Veteran home adaptations.

Specially Adapted Housing (SAH) Grant: This grant helps severely disabled veterans build, buy, or modify a home to meet their adaptive needs. This can cover features like ramps, wider hallways, roll-in showers, and accessible kitchens.

Special Housing Adaptation (SHA) Grant: This grant assists veterans with certain service-connected disabilities in adapting an existing home or buying a home that has already been modified.

Temporary Residence Adaptation (TRA) Grant: Provides grants for accessibility modifications to a family member's home where a veteran is temporarily living, which can be combined with either an SAH or SHA grant.

Home Improvements and Structural Alterations (HISA)

Grant: Offers medically necessary home improvements and structural alterations to address the veteran's disabilities,

even if they are not service-connected.
